 - O Jill Nickerson still has some work to do, but she hopes to have the park completed by the end of October. V.I.B.E. is also looking into insurance options for the park.
- Walking Trail

O There has been a very positive response to the idea of a walking trail in Blossburg. Members have been talking to property owners along the proposed trail to determine who is interested in allowing access to their property. Some landowners have expressed concerns about liability issues. Our current research shows that landowner liability will be limited thanks to Pennsylvania's Recreation Use of Land and Water Act.
